# 15th Sunday after Trinity — 29th September 2019

## Collect

Lord God,  
defend your Church from all false teaching  
and give to your people knowledge of your  
truth,  
that we may enjoy eternal life  
in Jesus Christ our Lord.

## Psalm 91: 11-16

For he will command his angels concerning you  
to guard you in all your ways.  
On their hands they will bear you up, so that  
you will not dash your foot against a stone.  
You will tread on the lion and the adder, the  
young lion and the serpent you will trample  
under foot.  
Those who love me, I will deliver; I will protect  
those who know my name.  
When they call to me, I will answer them; I  
will be with them in trouble, I will rescue them  
and honour them.  
With long life I will satisfy them, and show  
them my salvation.

## Reading: Deuteronomy 26: 1-11

When you have come into the land that the  
LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance  
to possess, and you possess it, and settle in it,  
you shall take some of the first of all the fruit  
of the ground, which you harvest from the land  
that the LORD your God is giving you, and you  
shall put it in a basket and go to the place that  
the LORD your God will choose as a dwelling for  
his name. You shall go to the priest who is in  
office at that time, and say to him, "Today I  
declare to the LORD your God that I have come  
into the land that the LORD swore to our an-  
cestors to give us." When the priest takes the  
basket from your hand and sets it down before  
the altar of the LORD your God, you shall make  
this response before the LORD your God: "A  
wandering Aramean was my ancestor; he went  
down into Egypt and lived there as an alien,  
few in number, and there he became a great

nation, mighty and populous. When the Egyptians  
treated us harshly and afflicted us, by imposing  
hard labour on us, we cried to the LORD, the God  
of our ancestors; the LORD heard our voice and  
saw our affliction, our toil, and our oppression.  
The LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty  
hand and an outstretched arm, with a terrifying  
display of power, and with signs and wonders;  
and he brought us into this place and gave us this  
land, a land flowing with milk and honey. So now  
I bring the first of the fruit of the ground that you,  
O LORD, have given me." You shall set it down  
before the LORD your God and bow down before  
the LORD your God. Then you, together with the  
Levites and the aliens who reside among you,  
shall celebrate with all the bounty that the LORD  
your God has given to you and to your house.

## Gospel: John 20:19-23

When it was evening on that day, the first day of  
the week, and the doors of the house where the  
disciples had met were locked for fear of the  
Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and  
said, "Peace be with you." After he said this, he  
showed them his hands and his side. Then the  
disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus  
said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the  
Father has sent me, so I send you." When he had  
said this, he breathed on them and said to them,  
"Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of  
any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins  
of any, they are retained."
